Dear Chairperson/Principal,

As you will be aware, schools are entitled to apply to the Revenue for a refund of tax paid on individual donations of €250 or more from any one individual taxpayer in a given year. The scheme has recently been changed so that it now applies to both PAYE and self-assessed taxpayers.

Should your school be in a position to avail of this scheme the Revenue have recently clarified that you do not need to use the relevant charity number but instead use the school roll number on the claims form you send in. Further information is available at <http://www.revenue.ie/en/personal/charities.html> .

For any other purposes relating to charity status, such as exemption from DIRT on bank accounts, the charity number CHY 7074 must be quoted as well as the charity name 'Parishes and Schools in the Diocese of Cloyne'.
